The main education given to a boy is to feed the family and provide it financially. One of the most important issues related to a young family is the relationship between young people and their getting used to a new system of relationships. Because it is natural that young people who have passed the stage of romantic love and liking each other have certain difficulties in experiencing everyday life based on the principles of new family life. The young man lives in his own house, in the conditions created by his parents. The heaviest of the difficulties in the adaptation process falls on the neck of the bride. One of the problems he has to deal with is establishing the proper etiquette for dealing with new family members. The Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan states that "The family is the main link of society and has the right to be under the protection of society and the state." According to the new "Family Code" and article 63, part 2 of our Constitution, "Marriage is based on the voluntary consent and equal rights of the parties." Article 16 of the "Universal Declaration of Human Rights" contains such clauses.

- 1. Men and women who have reached the age of majority have the right to marry and start a family without any restrictions based on their race, nationality, or religion. They enjoy the same right when entering into marriage, during marriage and at the time of annulment.
- 2. Marriage can be concluded only on the basis of free and full consent of both parties.
- 3. The family is considered the natural and basic unit of society and has the right to be protected by society and the state. At the same time, family law - the procedure and conditions for entering into marriage and annulment of marriage; relationships between spouses, parents and children resulting from guardianship and sponsorship, child adoption; consists of a set of legal norms that determine the manner of recording civil status documents. The final result of preparation for marriage and family life is the formation of readiness for family and marital relations. The readiness to organize an independent family life in the future is primarily the readiness of a person for family relationships, because the imperfection of these relationships primarily destabilizes the family. If the young generation is provided with sufficient theoretical information about the moral foundations of relations between men and women, as well as the experience of moral relations between them, the practice of moral behavior, and boys - girls o if there is a relationship between them, a person's readiness for marriage consists of a person's biological, social and psychological maturity. In folk wisdom, parents and their relationship with their children, mother's cultural and educational influence and wisdom are described in detail. Economic function: Finding material funds for others by certain family members, providing material support for minors and the elderly, and collecting funds form the basis of the economic function. Modern market relations require activation of the role of the family in matters of property accumulation, ownership, and inheritance.

Educational role: It plays an important role in the first socialization process of the child. The atmosphere and climate also have an effect on the formation of a child. One of the most important tools of education is a personal example. Nowadays, much attention is paid to preparing young people for family life. Resolution No. 820 of the Cabinet of Ministers dated 31.12.2020 "On measures to further develop the Family Institute and prepare young people for family life" was adopted. The regulation on the organization of activity centers for preparing young people for family life was approved by the decision. The centers were established under district, neighborhood, and family support departments, and they are assigned the following tasks:

- > To inculcate the exemplary form of the modern family and the conceptual ideas of "Family sacred", "Healthy family healthy society", "Family in the protection of society and the state" and "Prosperous family the basis of the development of society" in the minds of those getting married;
- > Systematic training of married persons on family-legal relations, psychology of family life, family economy and budget, basics of reproductive health, strengthening of spiritual and moral values:

➤ Ensuring the stability of families, preventing family divorces, respecting family values in married persons, creating a healthy spiritual and moral environment in families, and forming the skills of being exemplary parents.

# Such issues are aimed at properly preparing young people for family life and preventing family splits.

In conclusion, it should be said that the family is the main foundation for a person to find his place in life, to have honor and respect in the country, and to embody high moral rules. Educating young people mentally and physically is a priority of our state's policy. The foundation of education is laid in the family. Education is a complex and long-lasting unique process, which begins long before the birth of a child. That is, the future parents' health, lineage, outlook, inner and outer world, morals, morals, material and spiritual level, spiritual and physical readiness for marriage are important in raising children in the future.
