



Legal Consciousness and Legal Culture in Society Increase

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Abstract: Raising the legal awareness and legal culture in the society is one of the most important conditions for ensuring the rule of law and strengthening the rule of law.

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In recent years, significant work has been done to radically reform the national legal system, to form a legal culture in society and to train qualified legal personnel. At the same time, a number of problems and shortcomings remain, which hinder the formation of respect for human rights and freedoms, raising the legal awareness and legal culture of the population, raising the level of legal literacy of citizens in society. In particular, in raising the legal culture, first of all, the work on legal education and upbringing is not carried out systematically and systematically. For many years, the issue has been viewed as a matter for law enforcement and some government agencies, with insufficient involvement of the family, community, and other civil society institutions.

MATERIALS AND METHODS. The formation of legal immunity against the factors that negatively affect the legal education of young people, respect for the law and morality, loyalty to national values, intolerance of crime is not taken in a comprehensive way. The fact that the tasks of raising the legal awareness of the population are generally defined and there is no clear mechanism for their implementation shows that the work on raising the legal culture in the society is ineffective. [1] Insufficient efforts to inculcate in the minds of the population the idea of maintaining a balance between personal interests and the interests of society in raising legal awareness and legal culture also have a serious negative impact on the rule of law.

Insufficient legal knowledge of the population, as well as almost no use of the opportunity to appeal against illegal decisions of public authorities, lead to cases of discrimination of citizens' rights and legitimate interests by officials. In addition, in the current era of globalization, scientific and technological progress, innovative methods of raising the legal awareness and legal culture of the population, advanced and effective means of propaganda, the positive experience of foreign countries in this area are not used enough. RESULTS and DISCUSSION. At the same time, a number of problems and shortcomings remain, which hinder the formation of respect for human rights and freedoms, raising the legal awareness and legal culture of the population, raising the level of legal literacy of citizens in society. In particular:

first, the work to raise legal awareness and legal culture in society is not organized systematically and organically. There is no effective mechanism for providing legal information in the community, family, neighborhood, educational institutions and organizations. The idea of balancing the interests of the individual with the interests of society is not sufficiently inculcated in the minds of the population, especially civil servants;

secondly, the educational process in the system of continuing education is not carried out in accordance with legal education, the history, religion, customs and national values of the Uzbek people are not based on the formation of the legal culture of the population, especially youth;

thirdly, there is no effective system of cooperation with non-governmental non-profit organizations and other civil society institutions in the organization of activities to improve the legal culture, the work is not organized on the principle of social partnership;

fourth, there are no clear targeted measures to build legal immunity against factors that negatively affect the legal education of young people;

fifth, the active participation of government agencies and other sectoral services in the organization and implementation of targeted legal advocacy activities in society is not ensured, and there is a lack of efficiency and effectiveness in this regard;

sixth, legal activities are still carried out in the traditional way, through simple meetings, in which innovative methods of advocacy, including web technologies, are not used, and there are not enough legal websites;

Seventh, there are no legal mechanisms to encourage projects aimed at improving legal literacy, which are organized only in the name of activities, the publication and distribution of legal literature to improve legal knowledge, and research are ineffective.

In conclusion, to further improve the effectiveness of work to raise the legal awareness and legal culture of the population, to introduce modern methods of increasing legal knowledge of citizens in line with socio-political changes, as well as to protect the population, especially young people from harmful information. A number of measures are being taken to build strong legal immunity for protection.

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
